



Why? Oil on Canvas - 52" x 68.5" - Wang Weixing 2004

This painting is based on a true story. A mother and son were arrested in China simply because they practiced Falun Gong. Being beaten, the boy held back his tears asking: Why? Why did the policemen beat my mom and me?

Bathed in warm, golden light that represents resilient faith is Liu ChengJun, shortly before his torture-inflicted death. Ghastly images animate the floor, suggesting the horrors he endured in police captivity. Liu was arrested in March of 2002 for his part in a defiant television broadcast that exposed human rights violations. Although named in an *Urgent Action* by Amnesty International, Liu remained in captivity until his death.

A little girl comes home from school only to find her parents gone. The two pieces of white paper on the door are official notices stating that the house has been condemned by the "610 Office," a Gestapo-like organization set up specifically to target Falun Gong.
