Chinese Human Rights Lawyer Violently Arrested

Gao Zhisheng, an outspoken human rights lawyer from Beijing, was violently arrested on August 15, 2006.

He has not been heard from since. His life is in grave danger.

- Self-taught lawyer from rural China, Named one of China's top ten lawyers in 2001
- Has taken up human rights cases to help dispossessed farmers, coal miners, underground Christians, and Falun Gong practitioners.
- Has been a leader in a growing grassroots movement in China, protesting Chinese Communist Party's human rights abuses, and calling for rule of law.
- In Dec 2005, he publicly withdrew from the CCP.
